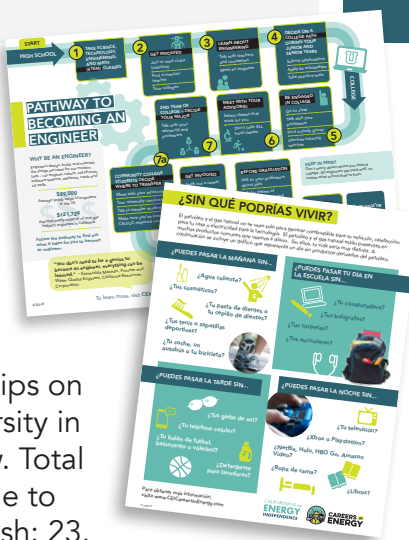
Since its inception in 2016, the Careers in Energy program has interacted with **more than 20,000 students** from communities across California.
